

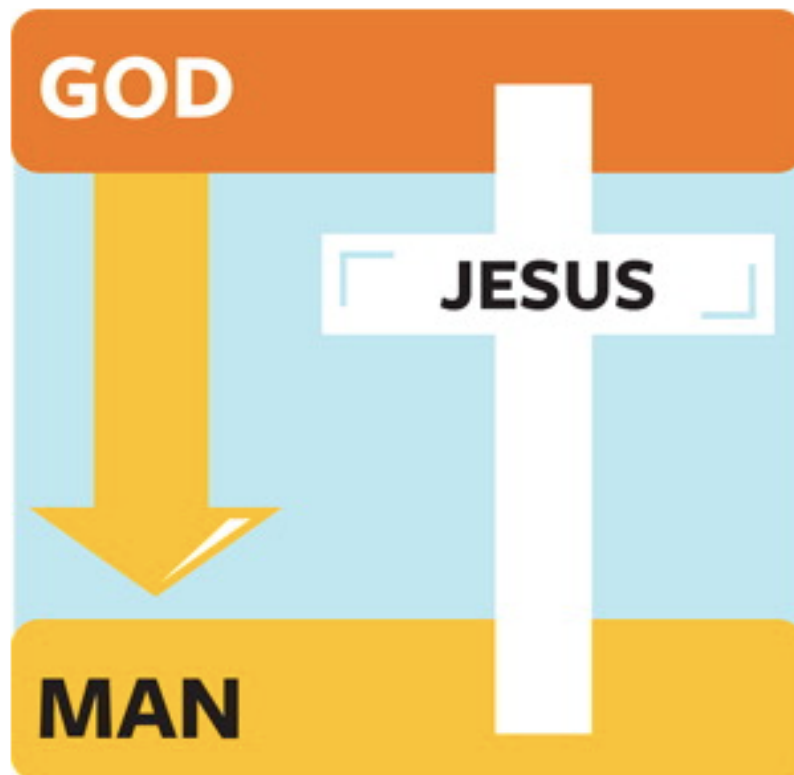
WHAT IS SALVATION?

The Apostle Paul wrote the book of Romans to the Christians who lived at Rome. He wanted to systematically present to them in written form the fundamental understandings of their faith. Therefore, it should come as no surprise that the process of salvation is clearly presented within its pages. Many refer to the following series of verses as ***The Roman Road*** -- leading the reader step by step to the point of understanding the need for accepting the GIFT of salvation that God holds out for anyone ready to receive it.

"for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,"
Romans 3:23 (pg. 1026)

"For the wages of sin is death, but the GIFT of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."

**"That if you confess with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,'
and believe in your heart that God raised
him from the dead, you will be saved."
Romans 10:9,10 (pg. 1032)**
